ATTACK ON FORT SUMTER

April 12, 1861 - Ft. Sumter was a Union/Northern fort located off the coast of South Carolina. When S.C. seceded from the Union, Ft. Sumter was left in enemy (Confederate/Southern) territory. The Confederate army fired on the Union fort, marking the official start of the Civil War. No one died in the battle, but the Civil War had officially begun.



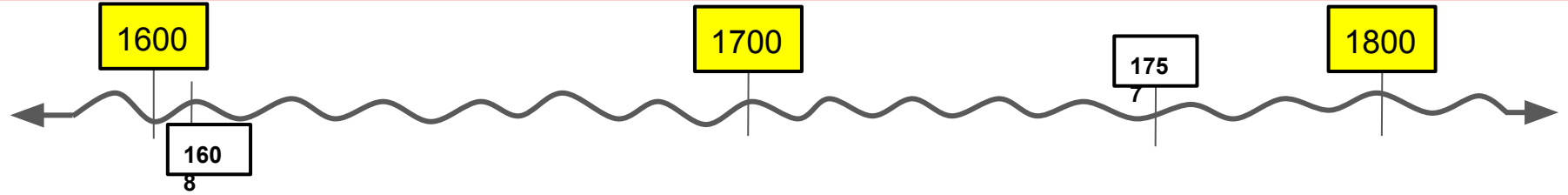
BATTLE OF ANTIETAM

September 1862 - The single bloodiest day in American military history with the Union suffering over 12,000 casualties and the Confederates suffering over 10,000. The battle was technically a draw, but since the Confederates retreated, the Union claimed it as a victory.
